- Forward-looking statements presented in this financial report, including forecasts of performance, are based on information currently available to SHR and on certain assumptions it deems to be reasonable. As such, actual operating and other results may differ materially from these forecasts as a consequence of numerous factors. These forecasts do not guarantee the distribution amount.
- At a meeting of the board of directors held on May 9, 2017, SHR passed a resolution to carry out issuances of new investment units through public offering and by way of third-party allocation. Payment for the issuance of new investment units through public offering was completed on May 24, 2017 and payment for the issuance of new investment units by way of third-party allocation was completed on June 12, 2017.

The above “2. Forecasts of performance for the fiscal period ending October 31, 2017 (May 1, 2017 – October 31, 2017) and the fiscal period ending April 30, 2018 (November 1, 2017 – April 30, 2018)” are based on the assumption of 969,000 units, comprising total 894,000 units issued and outstanding as of April 30, 2017 with the addition of the 71,400 units issued and outstanding through public offering and the 3,600 units issued and outstanding by way of third-party allocation.
